

**Documentation required when applying for a visa to move to Ireland to  
join a spouse who is an EU national**

MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE APPLICATION  
AS INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

**All documents listed must be original unless stated otherwise.  
All documents must be in English or  
accompanied by a notarised translation**

	<b>Document Required</b>	<b>Check Box</b>
1.	Online summary sheet, signed and dated by you, the applicant – you must ensure that your online application has been fully completed	
2.	Your original passport, valid for at least 12 months	
3.	One recent passport size photo	
4.	Evidence of your permission to remain in the UK (stamp or sticker in passport or on other approved official document provided by the UK authorities or a UK Identity Card)	
5.	The original marriage certificate ( a photo copy is not acceptable)	
6.	Your spouse's passport	
7.	Evidence that the EU Citizen spouse is exercising their EU Treaty Rights by being employed/self employed in the State or engaged in a valid vocational training programme or has sufficient financial resources and comprehensive sickness insurance cover	
8.	For postal applications, a self addressed Special Delivery envelope for return of your passport and documents	

**The Visa Officer reserves the right to request additional documentation, if required, in support of your application. The provision of all of the documentation listed in no way guarantees that a visa will be granted.**

Note: the visa provided will allow you to travel to Ireland. Once you arrive you should lodge an application to reside (Form EU1) with the Department of Justice Equality & Law Reform
