

**Documentation required when applying for a visa to
join a spouse on a work permit in Ireland**

AS INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

**All documents listed must be original unless stated otherwise.
All documents must be in English or
accompanied by a notarised translation**

	Document Required	Check Box
1.	Online summary sheet, signed and dated by you, the applicant – you must ensure that your online application has been fully completed	
2.	Your original passport, valid for at least 12 months after your date of departure from Ireland	
3.	One recent passport size photo	
4.	Evidence of your permission to remain in the UK (stamp or sticker in passport or on other approved official document provided by the UK authorities or a UK Identity Card)	
5.	Processing fee (postal orders or bank drafts should be made payable to the Embassy of Ireland). Note: Payments for postal applications should be by postal order or bank draft only.	
6.	The original marriage certificate (a photo copy is not acceptable)	
7.	Evidence of your spouse's permission to remain in Ireland including: (a) a copy of their valid work permit (b) a copy of their passport showing the bio page and the Irish Immigration stamps giving permission to work (c) a copy of their GNIB registration card	
8.	Your spouse's P60 from the most recent tax year	
9.	Your spouse's most recent 3 consecutive payslips	
10.	A detailed bank statement from your spouse covering the 6 month period immediately prior to your application	
11.	Details of your spouse's accommodation in Ireland	
12.	For postal applications, a self addressed Special Delivery envelope for return of your passport and documents	

The Visa Officer reserves the right to request additional documentation, if required, in support of your application. The provision of all of the documentation listed in no way guarantees that a visa will be granted.
