

Documentation required when applying for a visa to travel to Ireland
(a) for interview with the Medical Council
to obtain a temporary medical registration certificate
(b) to work as a temporary registered doctor
(c) to work as a fully registered doctor

AS INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

All documents listed must be original unless stated otherwise.
All documents must be in English or
accompanied by a notarised translation

	Document Required	Check Box
1.	Application form completed in full, signed and dated by you, the applicant	
2.	Your original passport, valid for at least 12 months	
3.	One recent passport size photo	
4.	Evidence of your permission to remain in the UK (stamp or sticker in passport or on other approved official document provided by the UK authorities)	
5.	Processing fee (postal order or bank draft made payable to the Embassy of Ireland or cash) Note: For postal applications, payment should be by postal order or bank draft only.	
6.	For interview with Medical Council: (a) letter from Medical Council stating eligibility for temporary registration and confirming interview details (b) letter from hospital confirming offer of employment (c) evidence of obligation to return to your country of permanent residence (e.g. letter from your current employer)	
7.	For temporary registered doctors: (a) Medical Council Registration book showing current registration (b) letter from hospital in Ireland confirming employment contract details	
8.	For fully registered doctors: (a) valid work permit (b) full Medical Council Registration Certificate	
9.	Evidence of Funds: Evidence of how you intend to finance your trip and support yourself for the duration of your visit in the form of up to date bank statements for the 3 month period prior to your visit. Bank Statements should include the most recent transactions for the account up to the date of your application and: (i) must be original (ii) must show your current address and (iii) must show a credit balance of at least £250. Lump sum	

	lodgements made shortly before your application will not be considered. Note: ATM receipts are not accepted.	
10.	For postal applications, a self addressed Special Delivery envelope for return of your passport and documents
